Foreign Language for Youth is offering two \$250 college scholarships to former students of their program. You must fulfill the criteria below in order to qualify and apply for this scholarship. Please write legibly and complete all parts of the application. If any of the questions do not apply to you, please write “N/A”. You will be notified by mail or email in May regarding the status of your application. If you have any further questions about this application, please email info@fl4y.org.

Criteria:

1. You must have participated in a FLY language series in elementary or middle school.
2. Taken at least two years of foreign language studies during high school.
3. Proof of acceptance to or enrollment in an accredited college or university.
4. Must be studying a foreign language/taking foreign language classes in college.
5. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale).

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items by **April 25 of the current year**:

1. Completed Scholarship application form
2. A 250-500 word essay describing how learning a foreign language at an early age helped you and the benefits of being multilingual.
3. Proof of acceptance or enrollment from the college or university named on your application under section 9. Proof must be provided prior to the receipt of funds.
4. Proof of GPA & ACT/SAT scores.
5. Attach the most recent official school transcript.
