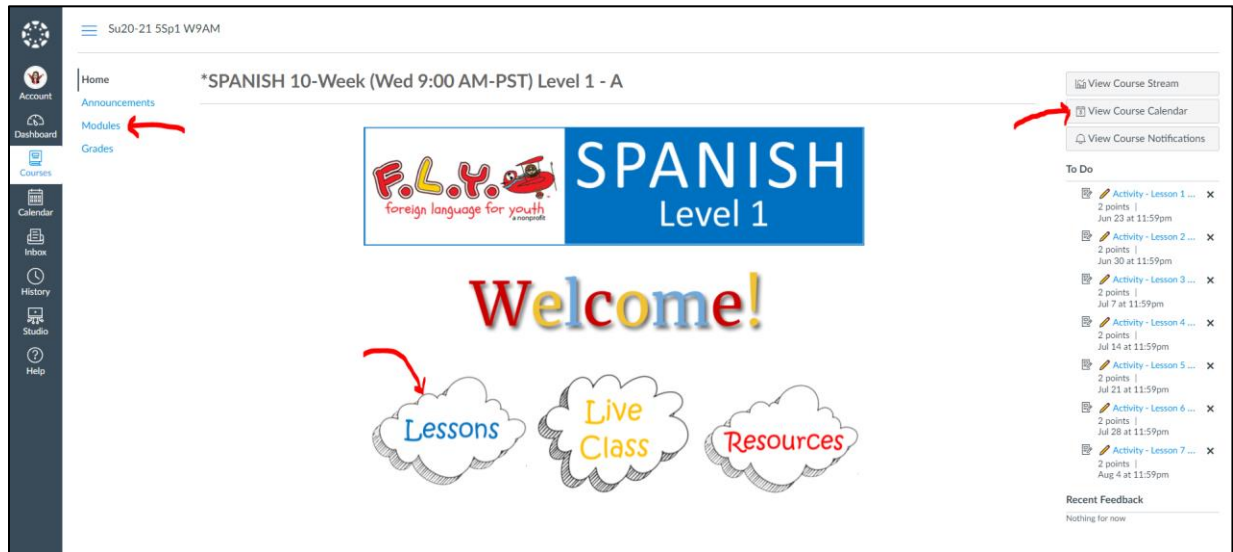
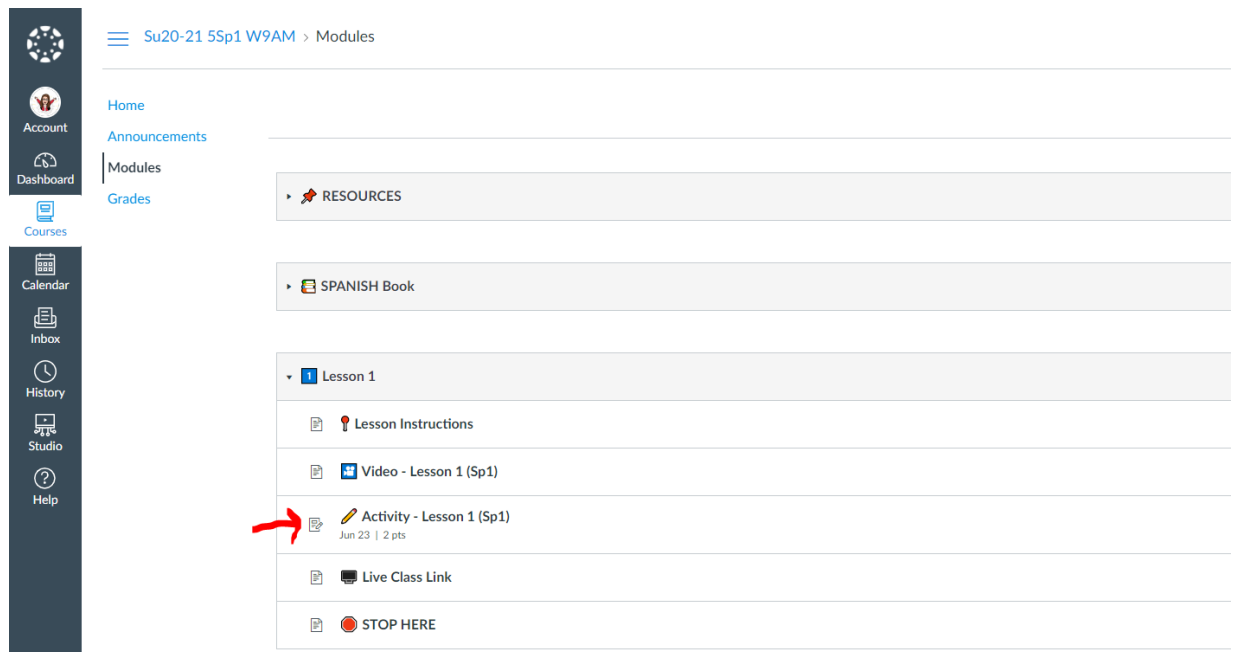


Complete & Turn in an Assignment Online

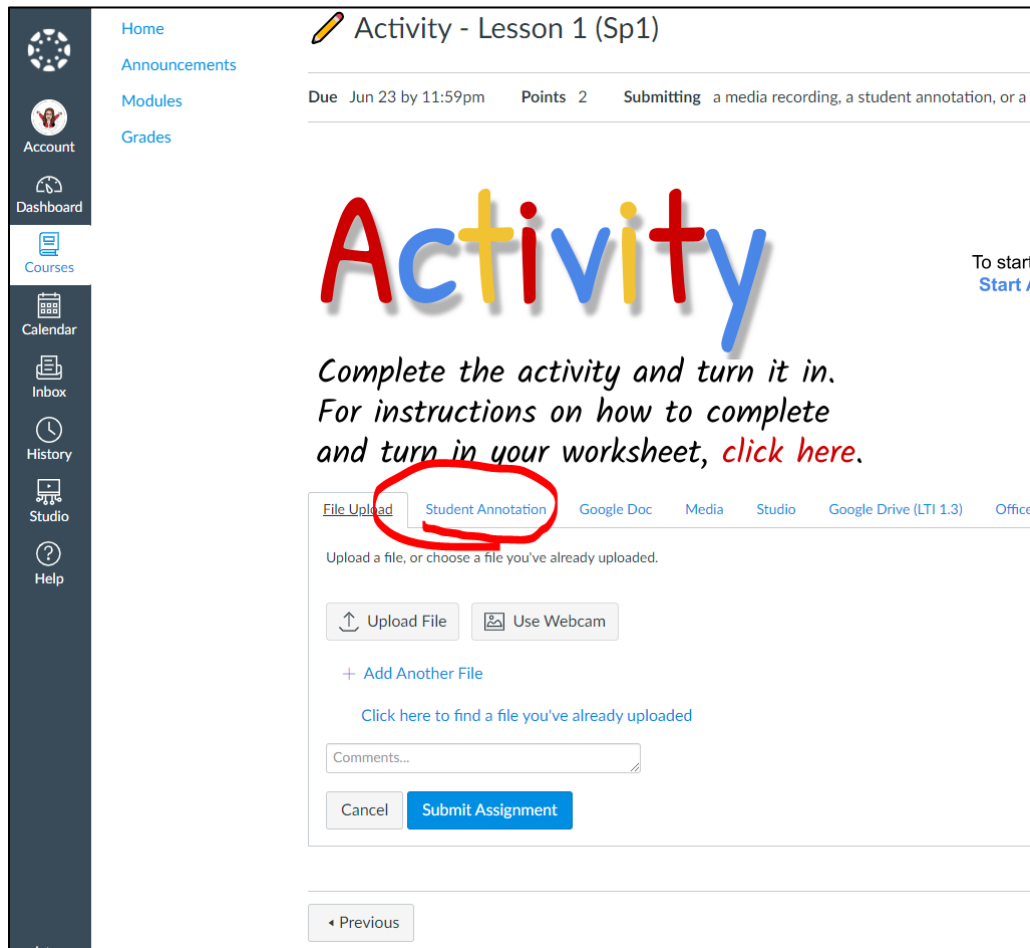
